Uniform Expectations-Blazers

As we move through the Spring Term and with the anticipation of warmer weather, I would like to take this opportunity to clarify our expectations with regard to school blazers.

In cooler weather, it remains our expectation that students will have blazers on whilst on the school site, but at the discretion of classroom teachers, blazers may be removed during lessons.

We recognise that in hot weather, students will become uncomfortable if they are wearing a blazer. Therefore, adopting a logical approach, the school will make a decision about when blazers need not be worn. In making that decision, we will consider regional forecasts and rises in temperature throughout the school day.

If we decide blazers do not need to be worn, we will inform students via staff in school, and parents/carers via the school website. Please support us by checking the website for updates.

As always, we appreciate your support and cooperation in ensuring that our students continue to adhere to our uniform expectations. Students who fail to meet the requirements of our clear uniform policy will be referred to SWAT so that contact can be made with parents/carers and suitable sanctions will be put in place.
