Dear Parents/Carers

As part of the year 9 PSCH curriculum students take part in a topic based on healthy relationships and I have arranged for a visit on 5th March from the Tackling Emerging Theatres to Children (TETC) service. TETC developed 'When I was 14', a verbatim play about youth violence and mental health that contains the real testimonies and stories of three Nottinghamshire residents who have personal experience with the issues at hand. The play runs for 50 minutes and is followed by a 50 minute workshop that aim to:

- challenge young people's thinking about the subject matter, particularly in respect of the stigma around mental health
- assist young people in being able to identify vulnerability, risk and harm in themselves and others
- equip young people with the knowledge and information needed in order to keep themselves and others safe with regard to mental health and youth violence

In addition to this our year 9 students have access to topics on health and wellbeing, fundamental British values and work skills and finance, a vital part of their educational development alongside the varied external providers we engage with to run specific sessions with our students.
