As part of the PSCH curriculum students are taught about a variety of personal, social, cultural and health related modules, as part of this they will consider health and wellbeing, relationships and fundamental British values.

As part of this, years 7, 8 and 9 students, will have a one hour lesson each week throughout the year. The students will study a range of topics including keeping healthy and safe, drugs, sex education, careers and community. In addition to this they will also be exploring finance, law and mental health.

To help deliver some parts of the modules, organisations and outside companies will be invited into school some of which include SEXions from Kings Mill Hospital and an educational theatre company called Pintsize. The key objective of these sessions is to educate our students on a range of issues and topics that they will face in both young and adult life.
