Half term 3- Relationships

Lesson 1 - No Hurry (Key objective: To understand the issues associated with promiscuity and unprotected sex)
Lesson 2 - HIV/AIDS (Key objective: To gain an understanding of HIV and AIDS, and the issues surrounding them)
Lesson 3 - Sexuality (Key objective: To examine the nature of sexual relationships, including homosexuality, and to understand the law in relation to those areas)
Lesson 4 - Marriage breakdown (Key objective: To understand the reasons why divorce happens and to examine the rights children and young people have when parents divorce)
Lesson 5 - Domestic Abuse (Key objective: To examine the issues of violence in the home and explore strategies for dealing with it)

Lesson 1 - Mental Health (Key objective: To understand and recognise the issues and dangers surrounding self-harm and suicide)
Lesson 2 - Stereotyping and Discrimination (Key objective: To examine the effects of stereotyping and discrimination and develop strategies for dealing with these problems)
Lesson 3 - Child Abuse (Key objective: To examine child abuse within the family and to look at the rights of children within this context)
