Design & Technology	<p><b>Festivals Homework</b></p> <p>There are many festivals held throughout the year by people all over the world. You are going to do some research into a Festival and produce a report covering different aspects of that event and create some design ideas based on it.</p> <p>1. Produce a front cover for the project, it should have the following information:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Your name;</li> <li>• The title (whichever Summer Festival you choose)</li> <li>• Your DT Group.</li> </ul> <p>2. Describe the Festival you have chosen, making sure you include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• When it is celebrated</li> <li>• Who celebrates it</li> <li>• Why it is special</li> </ul> <p>3. Produce a design for a greeting card using symbols which represent the festival.</p> <p>4. Festivals often have different foods served at them. Research the types of food served at your chosen festival and produce a menu.</p> <p>5. While celebrating the festival people often wear special clothes. Research and give examples of these clothes making sure you include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What are they commonly made from ?</li> <li>• What colours are used?</li> </ul> <p>6.
