English	<p>"Why is this homework task important?"</p> <p>This homework follows on from the homework completed before the October half-term.</p> <p>You will be studying the play 'Romeo and Juliet' by William Shakespeare. You will be responding to an examination question on this play in your GCSE English Literature exam in Year 11. You will not have a copy of the play in the examination and these homework tasks will prepare for this exam by teaching you some effective revision strategies.</p> <p>You will learn how to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Analyse an extract from the play effectively. • Select and memorise important quotations and understand which revision strategies work well for you. • Write clearly and in detail about the play in an examination situation, using information you have memorised. 	6 hours	05/11/2018	17/12/2018
Design Technology	<p>Each week students are required to read through different aspects of the GCSE revision guide in preparation for their next lesson. 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<p align="center">Geography</p>	<p>It is never too early to revise!</p> <p>For GCSE, Geography students will be provided with a blank A4 booklet and asked to prepare a selection of revision resources on the following topics for Component 1.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 'Living with the Physical Environment' • 'Challenges in the Human Environment' <p>There will be examinations on these topics at the end of Year 11.</p> <p>Although there are official revision guides to purchase (https://www.amazon.co.uk/Grade-GCSE-Geography-Revision-Guide/dp/1782946101/ref=sr_1_1?ie=UTF8&qid=1537862494&sr=8-1&keywords=geography+revision+guide+aqa) students always benefit from condensing their notes into a format which suits them.</p> <p>There will be a lesson dedicated to the explanation of the homework tasks and students will be shown basic revision techniques such as how to create an effective mind map, how to condense a case study and how to create a glossary of key terms.</p> <p>If after this point a student still feels unsure of how to complete revision activities then they should see a member of staff in the Geography department and also remember that there are 1 hour sessions after school on Thursdays which are targeted at offering this kind of support.</p> <p>There will be an opportunity for students to get some feedback on their work at the halfway stage of their homework, so it is heavily recommended that the tasks are done from the start date of the homework and not left until the final week!</p> <p>If any student wishes to discuss the task they should contact a member of the geography department as soon as possible.</p>	<p align="center">6 hours</p>	<p align="center">05/11/2018</p>	<p align="center">17/12/2018</p>
