History	<p><b>Tudors Homework Project: Continued from Half Term 1</b></p> <p>This project will allow students to be assessed on all the strands of the History National Curriculum – chronology, knowledge and understanding, historical enquiry, interpretations and organisation and communication.</p> <p>The Tudor royal family oversaw dramatic and wide ranging social, political and economic changes which saw England move from a medieval to an early modern nation. But, “How significant were the Tudor monarchs to the development of England?”</p> <p>Students will be given a homework project sheet suited to their ability and target level for Year 8 History.
