Geography	<p><b>Flipped Learning Task</b></p> <p>'The flipped classroom intentionally shifts instruction to a learner centred model in which class time explores topics in greater depth and creates meaningful learning opportunities'</p> <p>What this essentially means is that we will be asking the students to complete some work in advance of the lessons on a topic. It is expected that the students will use their own time to complete mind maps based on these topics. For some of these they will be provided with resources. For others they will need to do some research themselves.
